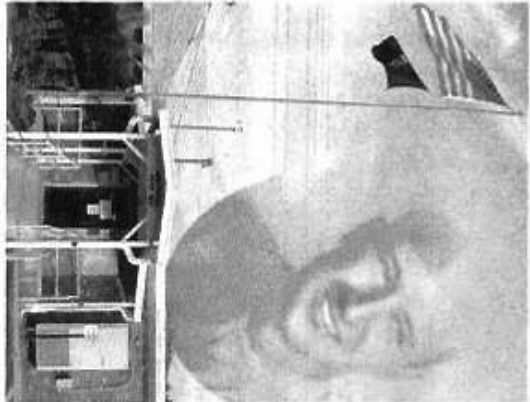

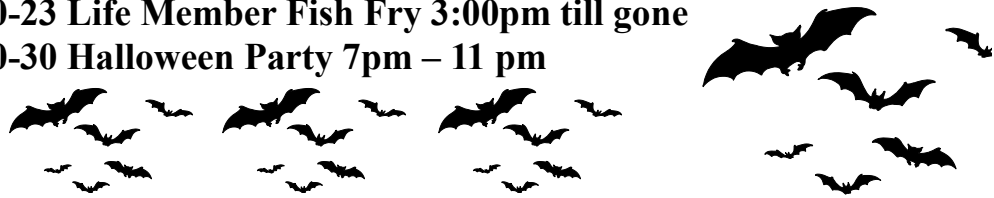
District Picnic for Girls and Boys State was another great success. And great time to enjoy one another while giving to a great program!
